SCHOLARSHIP SEASON HAS BEGUN

So far in 2010, The Elks National Foundation has awarded \$3.64 million in college scholarships through its three scholarship programs. The application process and deadlines vary for each program. However, the fact is that the application process begins **NOW**, not shortly before graduation.

1: Emergency Educational Grant; Grant applications are available to college aged children of deceased or totally disabled Elks members. Eligible students can request an application from scholarship@elks.org **NOW**.

2: Most Valuable Student Scholarship applications are available **NOW** by going to www.elks.org/ENF/scholars/mvs. Any High School Senior who is a citizen of the United States is eligible to apply. Applicants need not be related to a member of the Elks. Male and Female students compete separately. Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership and financial need. These scholarships range from \$1,000 per year to \$15,000 per year. These scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree, on a Full Time basis in a U.S. College or University. There will be 500 winners for the Class of 2011.

3: The Legacy Awards; Legacy Awards are \$4,000 scholarships (\$1,000 per year for four years). ENF will offer 250 awards to the class of 2011. Applications are available NOW at www.elks.org/ENF/schoars/legacy. Any child, grandchild, step-child, step-grandchild or legal ward of a living Elk is eligible. Great grandchildren are not eligible. The applicant must be a high school senior.

It has been the observation of this lodge's scholarship committee, that ultimate winners of these scholarships had **well prepared** applications which were not put together on some rainy Sunday afternoon. Winners' applications indicated a lot of time and effort. The time is to start NOW!

I mentioned this last year, however I feel so strongly about it, I want to repeat myself. It is an article called "Help Your Grandchildren Get Scholarships". You may get a copy by going to www.grandparents.com or step in our office and ask Joy, our very competent office assistant for a copy.

Oh, and yes the time is **NOW**!
