The early history of the Elks begins with the Jolly Corks... "When one of their members died shortly before Christmas in 1867, leaving his wife and children destitute, the Jolly Corks decided that in addition to good fellowship, they needed a more enduring organization to serve those in need. On February 16, 1868, they established the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks. Its social activities and benefit performances increased the popularity. Elks traveling to other cities spread the word of the Brotherhood of Elks."

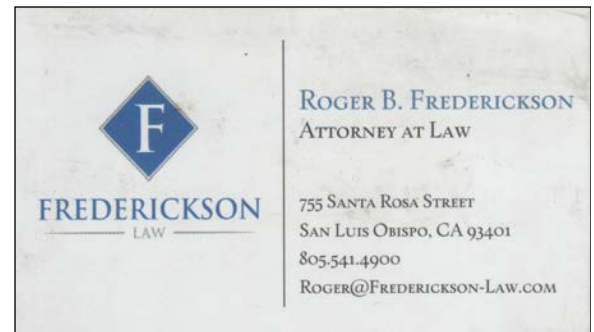
The station of the Esteemed Lecturing Knight represents the principle of Brotherly Love. "Brotherly Love is an extension of the natural affection associated with near kin, toward the greater community, that goes beyond the mere duty to "love your neighbor as yourself" and shows itself as "unfeigned love" from a "pure heart", that extends an unconditional hand of friendship that loves when not loved back, that gives without getting, and ever looks for what is best in others. Brotherly Love is the love for one's fellow person as a brother or sister. The expression is taken from the Greek word, Φιλadelphia aka Philadelphia, which means "love of brothers."

Brotherly Love is not relegated to only men, nor should it be applied to only brothers. This is love between siblings and should always include the love between sisters. It is genuine friendship between all of humankind.

As we prepare for the holidays, most of us look forward to being around our family members, mom and dad, brothers and sisters. For many, home is a place of love, warmth, and comfort. It's somewhere that you know you will be surrounded by care and support. But for millions of others, home is anything but a sanctuary. The U.S. Department of Justice estimates that 1.3 million women are victims of physical violence by an intimate partner every year. Every 9 seconds, a woman in the U.S. is beaten or assaulted by a current or ex-significant other. Unfortunately, the statistics show that Domestic Violence actually **INCREASES** during the holidays, whether or not reported to law enforcement.

Out of this feeling of Brotherly Love, when your "brother or sister" confides in you that they are victims of abuse, start showing your support by believing them. In this season of giving, let us remember to make donations to our local women's shelter, Stand Strong or RISE. These non-profit organizations are always accepting donations, but especially for the holidays, items like shampoo, laundry or dishwashing detergent, grocery store, gas, or other store gift cards are greatly needed and appreciated.
