CHILI & BEAN COOK-OFF AT THE LODGE

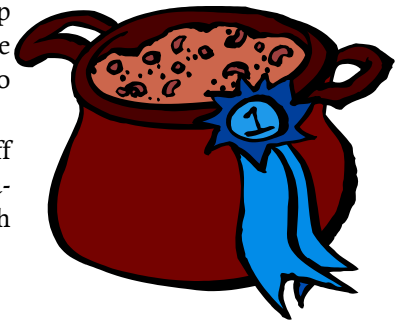

The R.V. Park is located on Farm Road 1586 off U.S. Highway 183 between Luling and Gonzales, across from the Texas Elks Children's Services Facility in the Ottine. The Park has 54 sites, 23 have 50 amp electric service, water and sewage connections, 21 have concrete pads, 2 are pull-through; 28 have 30 amp electric service and water, 12 have concrete pads; 3 sites have 30 amp electric service only. There is a dump station.

The park has restroom facilities for men and women.

There is a meeting room that is heated and air conditioned with a small kitchen. It has tables and chairs to comfortably seat 45 people. This room is available to R.V. groups.

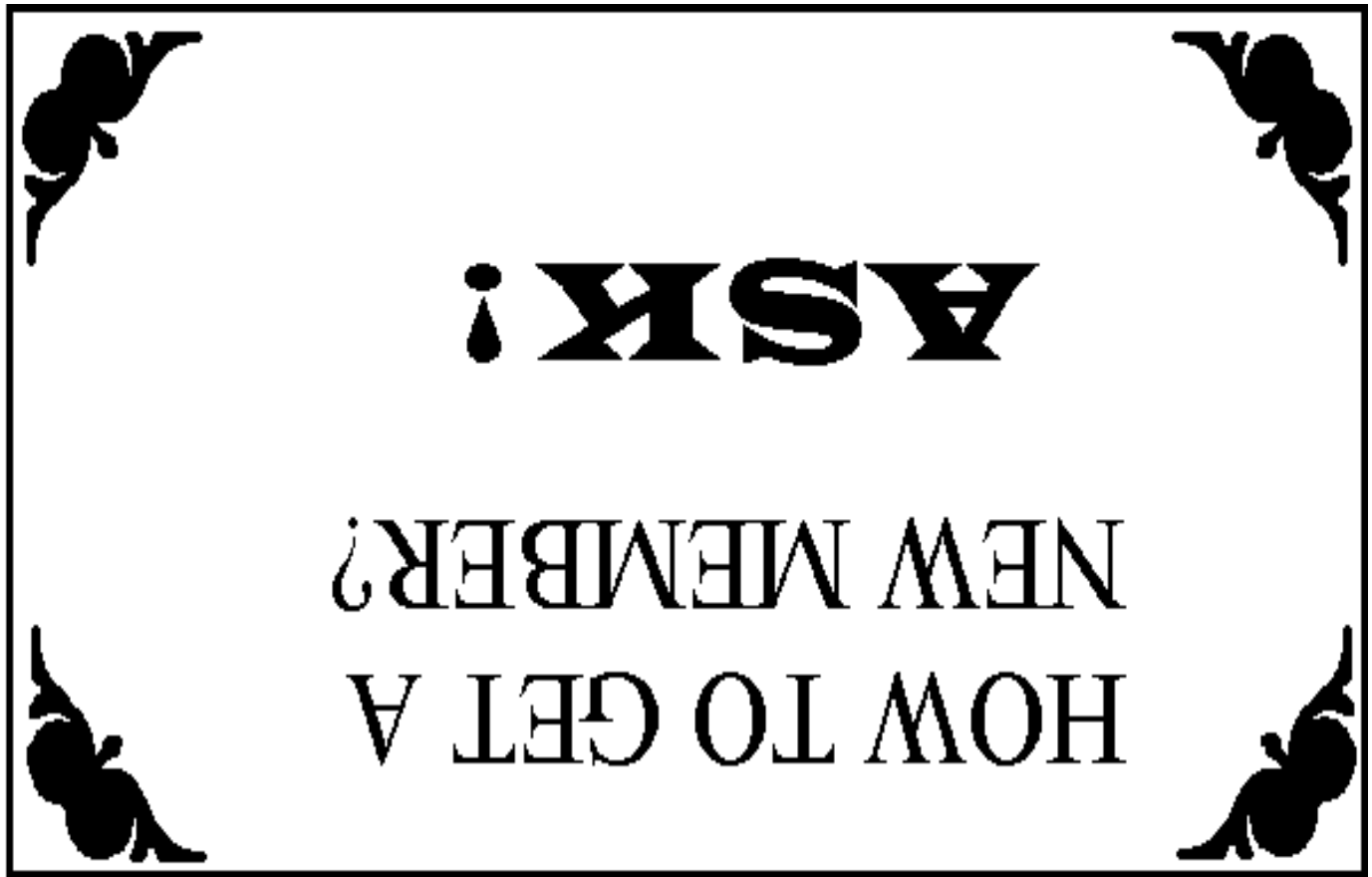
