# **VETERANS' SERVICES**



To update you on our Brick Paver Project, Tom Krieger and I rented a stump remover to clear the stumps and Troop 217 Eagle Scout, Aaron Shaw, started working on the project. So, we need your application and \$60 asap so we can get these pavers ordered. You can get a form from the bar or pick one up at Veteran's Hall. Fill it out (printing carefully) and pay at the bar with check, cash, or credit card. The 8" x 8" engraved Memorial Paver cost \$60.00. If you have any questions, my number is on the form; so, you can call me.

We had several requests from members for the Military Bracelets. We now have some at the bar for sale, and, if you would like any to sell, contact Bob Behm.

In April, the Veterans Stand Down that was held for homeless veterans at Bay Pines VA was a success. Our Lodge donated \$1,000 dollars to Edgard Solivan, the VSA at Bay Pines, for this event. Hopefully, next year we can get a Grant to host a breakfast for them. Also, in April, the Vietnam Americans from neighboring communities held an event at the Wounded Warriors Abilities Ranch in Pinellas Park to honor the sacrifices of the Republic of Vietnam and its allies, including America.

On May 4th, there will be a Woman's Veterans baby shower at Bay Pines. More to follow.

On May 30th, there will be a free Dental Veterans' Clinic in Lakeland for all veterans. You must pre-register. There are flyers in the Veterans Room.

Also, on May 30th, the Veterans Committee will be participating and providing water during the City of Largo's Memorial Day Ceremonies at Largo Central Park.

I hope when you go through the Veterans Room to the dining room, you look at the veterans wall of pictures honoring our Largo Elks Veterans. As you can see, it is filling up, but there is plenty of room left for all our other veterans. If you are a veteran of any service, please get me a 5 by 7 picture of you in uniform or with you wearing a cap with your service indicated. On the back of the picture, put your name, rank, branch of service, and years served. If you were in a conflict, you can put that on the back also. Remember, this wall is to honor your service to your country.
