### **Our State Major Project**

Meet Oramae, a four year old babe with Down Syndrome, Cerebral Palsy, Cortical Visual

Impairment (Mom says she sees shadows) and she had a Cerebrovascular Accident (stroke) prenatally. At birth she had multiple issues including a ventral septal defect ("hole" in her heart), infantile spasms (seizures that can cause further brain damage) and Ori was not able to coordinate her suck swallow which lead to formula going into her lungs. The septal defect of her heart has resolved, a G tube was placed so Ori can get nutrition, hydration and medication as she continues to have seizures.



One of the therapy exercises for Ori is something we likely take for granted, being able to sit independently. When Ori's therapist positions her in sitting, her muscle tone fluctuates between high and low. She

can maintain sitting with head and trunk control for a short time if she is placed with her hips flexed, legs in a circular position and the soles of her feet together. Being on her tummy or her side just isn't tolerated.



Oramae has a love for music. When she is upset a James Brown tune can turn the day around. Electronic dance music is also appreciated by Ori. She loves her adaptive swing, going on walks in her neighborhood and having her 2 year old sister read her favorite books

to her.

Oramae and her family want to say THANK YOU to the Washington State Elks for this unique home therapy program. The one-on-one emphasis during home visits addresses the many issues of a very unique and complicated little girl.
