





# "Our Kids" Washington Elks Therapy Program for Children, Inc.



We are excited for you to meet Kimberley!

Born at 24 weeks gestation, Kim would have challenges ahead of her, including a diagnosis of Cerebral Palsy (CP). The specific type of CP Kim has is called quadriplegia. This means that all 4 of her limbs as well as her body are affected. Some of her muscles are "low tone" or "loose" which affect her ability to stay sitting and keep her head up, yet others have



"spasticity" which means they are very tight especially in her arms and legs. So far Kim has endured 3 surgeries to release some of these tight muscles. Each time Kim has surgery it is a set-back and she has to learn how to use her muscles all over again. She has to work on her core strength and remind her legs what their function is. In the first few years it was a struggle for Kim's family to find therapy for her. Access to therapy resources in her area were very limited and what was available did not specialize in pediatric therapy. So, when Kim was 3 she became one of "Our Kids" and began Occupational Therapy with the Elks Therapy Program for Children.

Fast forward to 2017! Kim has transitioned through Elementary School to Middle School and now she is in High School. In fact, Kim just turned 15 and celebrated her quinceañera! She enjoys participating in school, taking her animals to the fair and spending time with her family and friends. Each day offers Kim challenges yet she continues to progress. With help from her Elks Therapist, Kim is working toward gaining skills and independence with her activities of daily living (ADL's) including dressing and toileting. She has moved from using a manual wheelchair to a power wheelchair and she is even working on getting into and out of her wheelchair. Kim also works hard on using her hands for fine motor skills and using a tablet for schoolwork, and of course, for a little fun.

- TAKE IN MEMBERSHIP DUES AND SEND OUT MEMBER CARDS. (BUSIEST BETWEEN MARCH-JUNE)
- PROCESS ANY MEMBERS DIMIT, DROP, OR DEATH IN THE ELK'S DATABASE (CLEMS)
- PREPARE LODGE MEETING AGENDA, AND PUBLISH LODGE MEETING MINUTES
- ATTEND TWO MANDATORY DISTRICT DEPUTY MEETINGS. (USUALLY A DAYTRIP. GAS PAID BY THE LODGE)
- ATTEND TWO MANDATORY 4 DAY CONFERENCES (TRIP PAID BY THE LODGE)
- INTAKE OF ALL MONEY AND APPLY TO THE PROPER BUDGET/ACCOUNT.
- BALANCE MONEY BAGS FOR BAR, KITCHEN, BINGO, AND EVENTS AND PREPARE THE BAG FOR THE NEXT WEEK OR EVENT.
- PREPARE DEPOSITS AND TAKE TO THE BANK
