We have wrapped up our \$2000 Freedom Grant for this year! The grant funding was dedicated for two purposes: Half for food and gas assistance and half for special projects that benefitted local veterans.

With this ENF funding, we were able to help ten local veterans with either food or gas assistance. We discovered that the need is greater when it comes to gas assistance, due to the great distances veterans are forced to travel to obtain medical treatments.

There were several special projects that we undertook as a lodge to support our local heroes. In mid winter, we discovered that two member veterans were in need of additional heating in their homes. We purchased two high quality space heaters for these member veterans and have heard they are being put to good use.

Roofing was another area that we received several requests for assistance. Thanks to the Freedom Grant, we were able to purchase materials to weather seal two local homes belonging to veterans. Special thanks to the Elks members who came out to do the labor on these two projects—Tyler Massey, Glenda Greene, Maria Sanchez, Lou Montenegro, Chris Garza and Kelly Gomez.

The final, major undertaking with this funding was the installation of a new porch for veteran Nick Paulos in Lordsburg. The porch replaced an old, rickety structure and included the addition of a much-needed handicap ramp. L&J Landscaping was a huge help in hammering out the details on this project. Much thanks to them!

We feel we were able to put this Freedom Grant money to tremendous use and in the process identified need of our veteran community. Plans are in the works to apply for this funding. Anyone wishing to help out on this committee, please contact me.

Our veterans are our heroes and as Elks we vow to never forget them!


Flores, Bejarano initiated into order


