Greetings from the Leading Knight

The remaining House Rules, #11-19, are listed below. If you have any questions or need clarification, reach out to one of the House Committee members, officers or trustees.

- 11. No beverages are allowed to be brought into the Lodge building, with no exceptions. No alcoholic drinks are allowed in the Lodge Room during Lodge meetings. No open containers will be allowed to leave the Lodge facilities.
- 12. No personal credit shall be extended to anyone. All checks will be made to Nevada Elks Lodge #564. Only checks from paid up Members will be accepted. The limit of checks and amount will be governed by the House Committee. Writing bad checks will result in revocation of check cashing privileges until reinstated by the House Committee.
- 13. After a member leaves the premises, all monies left on the bar or tables will be considered as a tip for the Bartender, within reason.
- 14. No furniture or furnishings will be permitted to leave the Lodge building, except for organized Elk activities or unless approved by the Trustees of the Lodge.
- 15. All activities of the Lodge will be approved by the committees involved and the House Committee. All persons renting the basement and Bingo Building will be required to make a deposit and sign an agreement of Rules and Regulations.
- 16. Each committee will be responsible for setting up tables, cleaning up after, etc. for their activity. The House Committee will handle and furnish all monies from the bar.
- 17. The House Committee Officers and Past Exalted Rulers of Nevada Elks Lodge #564 have authority to ask a member or Members to leave

the Lodge building for unruly behavior and violations of these House Rules and Regulations .18. Observance of these rules will make our Club Rooms a place of enjoyment and pride for all our members and their guests. Your cooperation in observing and enforcing these rules is solicited and expected.

19. Nevada Elks Lodge #564 is non-smoking/smoke-free. (This includes vaping.)
In sharing the rules, it is the hope of the Board of Directors and House Committee that all Members are reminded of the purpose of the Elks Organization, "To promote and practice the four cardinal virtues of Charity, Justice, Brotherly Love and Fidelity; to promote the welfare and enhance the happiness of its members; to quicken the spirit of American Patriotism and cultivate good fellowship."
