VETERANS' SERVICES

As Chair for the Veterans Committee, I have been asked by several members as to why the Elks Lodge and my committee run events for our veterans in the lodge. They say why are you trying to compete with the American Legion and the VFW who also host veteran events and programs?

The simple answer is right in the Elks Motto which is, "As long as there are Veterans, the Elks will never forget them." Today, our lodge is involved with numerous programs and activities that support our veterans, active-duty troops, and their families. It is also about choice, and the fact that you as a veteran can go to any of these activities, including our events.

I challenge these same veterans to get on the Veterans Committee to make a difference in our community. I belong to both organizations, the Legion and the VFW, and they don't do half of the activities that we do in our lodge for veterans. Some of our

activities that the committee participates in: Welcome Home Kits – We work with the Social Workers at the Bay Pines VA Facility to get homeless veterans off the streets and into an apartment. We try to give them everything they need to set up their apartment. We have delivered 143 kits in the last couple of years.

Veterans Clothing Drive – We have Veterans Clothing Drives quarterly, or when we have a lot of donated items. We collect both men and women's clothing and personal hygiene items. We either take them to the Veterans Mall or to Pinellas Safe Harbor Shelter. We also apply for an ENF Grant for \$2,500 each year to provide the Pinellas Safe Harbor Shelter with food.

Liberty Manor Shelter – The Veterans Committee takes turns cooking a meal once a week for the 6 veterans who live at the shelter in Largo.

Manufacturer Coupons – Our volunteers collect, sort, bundle, and mail coupons to military bases around the world to help military families. If you get coupons from the paper or in the mail, bring them in and put them in the cabinet in the Veterans Room. These are not your Publix or Winn Dixie coupons, but manufactures' coupons. This group also mails Christmas cards to the troops.

Little Big Feet – We collect knitted/crocheted baby items, and they are mailed to Jacksonville Naval Base Hospital to the Pediatric Department.

Participation in the City of Largo Memorial Day and Veterans Day events - The Veterans Committee purchases and passes out the water for these two events. We also participate in the ceremonies.

Annual cookout at Bay Pines – We apply for a grant for a cookout for about 240 veterans and staff at Bay Pines. Members of the Veteran Committee then host, cook, and serve each year. This year the event will take place on Saturday, October 5th. We are usually joined by Holiday Isle Elks as we also help them with their cookout. This year we will also be serving and providing breakfast for the Stand Down annual event at Bay Pines.

Veterans Week in the lodge - Every 3rd week in the month is Veterans Week in the lodge, and we serve pies for donations and host a group of veterans from Solaris Health Care down the street.

Taco Night in the Lodge – The committee cooks tacos twice a month for the lodge as the proceeds are a fundraiser for the Veterans Committee. The other two weeks, the Youth Activities Committee serves tacos or pulled pork sandwiches as a fundraiser for youth projects.

We can always use your help. Although we have over 100 Elks on our Veterans Committee, it's always the same group of about 20 volunteers that are doing everything. Come out to one of our meetings. We meet every 3rd Monday at 6pm in the lodge. We all as ELKS can make a difference for veterans! Bob Behm, Veterans Committee Chair
