Grants Update

Beacon Grant

We received \$4,000 for the Thanksgiving project where we will provide Thanksgiving meals for approximately 80 families in the Jefferson City area. The event will take place on Saturday, November 23rd. There will be a sign-up sheet on the bulletin board in early November. This grant is provided by the Community Investment Program through National Elks.

Freedom Grant

This grant will provide new winter coats for homeless/veterans in transition and their families. The Grant is for \$1,000. We will supplement this grant with money from our Veterans fund.

Spotlight Grant

I am currently working on this grant which is a total of \$2,000. We will be using this grant in conjunction with the Freedom Grant to purchase winter coats.

Operation Toys

Children shopping with law enforcement. This event will take place on 12-14-2024.

It is crucial to the success of these programs that we reach the per capita amount of \$5.00 per member. Currently, Lodge #513 is at \$3.40 per member. 1.03% of the members have donated to the Elks National Foundation. You can give your donation to Betsy Crawford or myself at any time.

Scholarship District Chair Report

Most Valuable Student Scholarship

MVS scholarship opened August 1st 2024 and the deadline for applications is November 12th 2024. The MVS scholarship is open to all high school seniors and the application is online at enf.elks.org/MVS. Often, students are unaware of the availability of the Elks Scholarships. Students' parents do not have to be Elks members and it's very important that they have this information. Students are given a list of lodges in their area and they can choose which lodge they want to score their application. The judging will be based on leadership, service, academics and financial needs. The top 20 applicants across the country will receive \$30,000 scholarships. The 480 runners-up will receive \$4,000. After the applications are completed, they are scored by the local lodge and then send to the district level. I will be looking for Elks to assist with the district scoring sometime in early December. The State scoring is in February and all district chairs are invited to participate in this scoring process.

Legacy Scholarship

The 2025 contest and application will open on September 1st, 2024 and the deadline for applications is February 3, 2025. For the 2025 contest, any child or grandchild (or step-child, step-grandchild, or legal ward) of a living Elk who joined the Order on or before April 1st, 2022, or a charter member of a lodge that was instituted on or before April 1st, 2022 is eligible to apply. The Elk must be a paid-up member through March 31st, 2025. Great-grandchildren are not eligible. The standardized test requirement for the 202 Legacy contest has been waived so students do not need to submit an ACT and/or SAT scores. If a student is selected for a Legacy Awards recipient, they will be required to perform three instances of services with an Elks Lodge during the four years they receive the scholarship. Legacy awards are \$4,000.

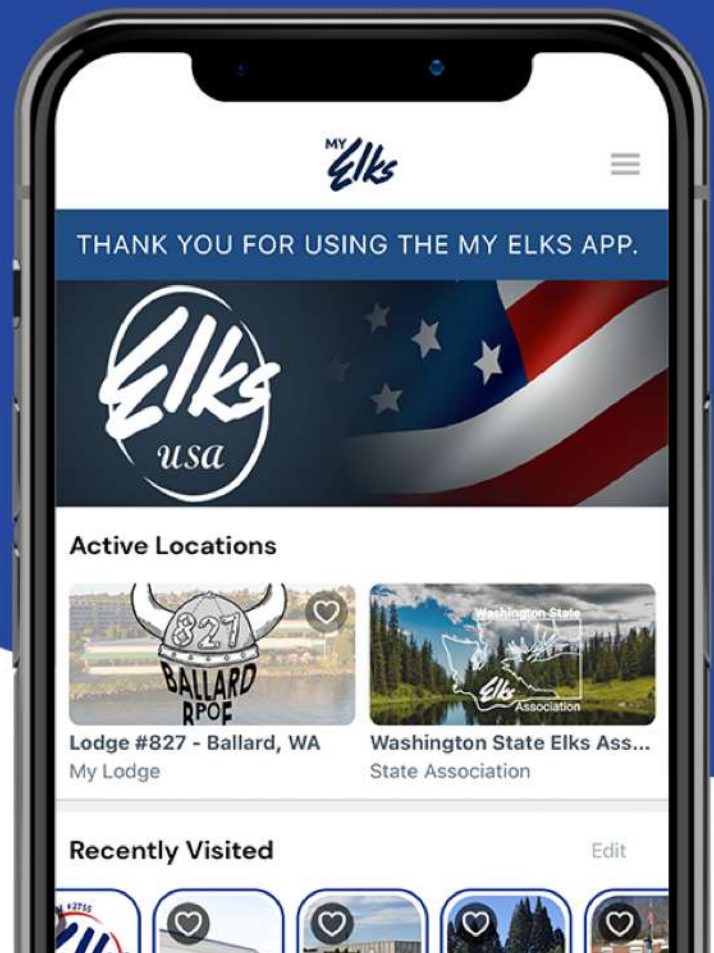
