

MOST VALUABLE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

THE SCHOLARSHIPS: The Norwin Elks Lodge #2313 will award a minimum of two \$1000 scholarship awards for the 2024-2025 academic year. The financial award must be used for tuition or direct educational costs at any approved college or postsecondary vocational institution. Acceptance of our scholarship does not preclude the winner from receiving any other scholarship unless other restrictions prevail.

CONDITIONS OF THE AWARD: Applicants must meet the following conditions:

- A graduating high school senior attending an accredited school within the boundaries of Norwin Elks membership. This includes the school districts of Penn-Trafford, Norwin, Hempfield, Jeannette, Greensburg-Salem, Plum, Franklin-Regional, and Gateway.
- A son, daughter, or grandchild of an active (or deceased) Norwin Elks Lodge #2313 member.
- The applicant must submit a completed application to the Norwin Elks Lodge #2313 no later than 5:00 PM on <u>Wednesday, March 15, 2017</u>. The Signature Page must be attached.
- The applicant must be accepted to an approved postsecondary school.
- The applicant <u>should not</u> include supportive information, such as letters of recommendation. Our procedure for selecting scholarship winners <u>does not</u> include supportive information.

<u>APPLICATION DEADLINE</u>: As stated in 'Conditions' above, all completed applications must be received at the Norwin Elks Lodge no later than <u>5:00 PM on Wednesday, March 15, 2017</u>.

<u>SELECTION OF WINNERS</u>: The selection of scholarship winners will be done by the Norwin Elks Scholarship Committee. Winners will be personally notified in late April or early May.

NOTE: Alt scholarship applicants are expected to be good citizens. Our award may be revoked if applicants fail to represent themselves, their family, their school, or our lodge in a positive way.

METHOD OF SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT: The \$500 award will be paid directly to a winner's postsecondary school. The award will be sent after the *conclusion of the first semester* of the 2017-2018 academic year, to be used for the second semester needs.
