We are Elks, Caring for All! As we end this Elk Year, we continue fundraising in the research towards stamping out Disease's and developing places for our future children to play. We are working diligently to accomplish so much for our Future Leaders. We have seen progress and know we have so much more to do! I thank all the Arizona Elks, Lodges and organization contributing to this worthwhile Major Projects.



So, what have we done and Continue to Do? We are celebrating our 32nd year associated with the Steele Center and have contributed nearly \$10 million to date. AEMP also owns and operates a youth camp open to all organized youth groups in the State of Arizona. This is a true wilderness camp with some cell service and Internet for the Group and Camp Leaders.



We have raised funds to purchase the Pea Pod body composition machine. This machine is the first in Arizona and will be used for clinical and research purposes. Our team will measure the growth of a baby's lean mass and fat free mass, which impact the baby's outcomes in development and metabolic health lead to healthier children. This beautiful baby is Emily Victoria Laaff. She grabbed my heart some 23 years and 7 months ago. She was only a part of my life for 7 months, but her smile, her tiny arms reaching out to me and her incredible full belly laugh are etched in my memory. Emily was taken from her Mother [Deborah Laaff](#) and her Father Andres and me on July 5th 2001. Taken by cancer, Leukemia to be exact. Deborah called me Emily's magic man, because with one deep look and a little smile she could make me sing and act a fool, just to hear her laugh, to see her tiny arms reach out. I think of Emily whenever I am near [U of Arizona Steele Children's Research Center/Dept. of Pediatrics](#) and as Arizona Elks President Sue's 1st Gent, I am making Pediatric Cancer research my quest, in the name of Emily. There is a cure in the future, it just takes money to get there. Every dollar we raise is a dollar closer. But the effort needs thoughts, words and deeds as well. Less than 10% of the Cancer research being done is focused on children. They don't have a voice. Help me be the voice for Emily and every child like her. Just saying a prayer and wearing my lapel pin can help. I will post an address for Steele if you want to go directly to them. Working on Credit Card collection efforts through Steele as well.
