- A new band Smooth Play will debut August 23rd.

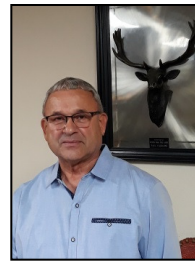
Both play many popular venues in central Florida so please come hear them on the 9th and 23rd of August.

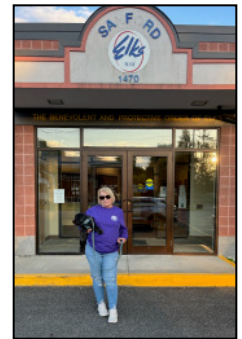
## Wandering Elks


