Greetings fellow members,

June was a busy month as we celebrated Father's Day and honored our nation's flag with the annual Flag Day ceremony. We initiated several new members into our order as we continue our drive to grow our Lodge and in turn, our outreach. Esteemed Loyal Knight Victor Rose and the Veterans Committee have continued to provide Welcome Home Kits for veterans transitioning into housing.

The last weeks of June were marked by terrible wildfires around Ruidoso. This was the worst I've seen in the 20 years, I've been living here. Destruction and disruption on a scale rarely seen in our region led to an overwhelming response of support from our community. Las Cruces is truly a generous community and the Las Cruces Elks Lodge is a big part of that. Our trustees worked to coordinate our relief efforts and gather donations while we offered to open the Lodge to shelter folks who had been displaced. We were able to fill a 12' trailer of items needed and deliver them to the Inn of the Mountain

Gods for distribution. George and a crew made 200 burritos to be delivered also. The quick response and contributions of our lodge members was awesome. Thank you everyone who contributed and assisted in this effort. As of the time of writing this the fires are still ongoing as well as our efforts to aid those who need it. You're continued support and prayers are appreciated.

The end of the month several of our members and I will be attending the Grand Lodge convention in Austin, TX. There we will participate in meeting to vote on proposed statute changes. In addition, we will meet with New Mexico Elks President, Glenda Greene, and fellow lodges to come up with plans on how to best assist Ruidoso going forward as they continue to fight the fire and rebuild their town.

Finally, I want to ask you all again to familiarize yourselves with the national website (Elks.org) and enroll in a reoccurring payment to the Elks National Foundation (ENF). ENF is how the Grand Lodge funds all the grants we apply for and the amount we contribute can qualify us for more funds. You can choose to pay as little as \$5 a month but if enough members contribute that will go a long way.




Member Orientation and Initiation will be July 14th

Together we did it!


In just a few days our members came together to help those in need in Ruidoso during the devastating fires and flooding.



Upon attaining membership in our Order, you will become part of a National Organization, which has members from every prominent city of our Country, who are respected citizens in their communities and are proud to say that they belong to the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of the United States of America. The Order of Elks was formally organized on February 16, 1868,

in the City of New York, NY. Its

full corporate name is "Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of the United States of America." Its declared purposes are to practice its four cardinal virtues, Charity - Justice – Brotherly Love - and Fidelity; to promote the welfare and enhance the

happiness of its members; to quicken the spirit of American patriotism; and to cultivate good fellowship.

The animal from which the Order took its name was chosen because a number of its attributes were deemed typical of those to be cultivated by members of the fraternity. The elk is distinctively an American animal. The elk habitually lives in herds. The largest of our native quadrupeds, it is yet fleet of foot and graceful in movement. It is quick and keen of perception; and while it is usually gentle and even timorous, it is strong and valiant in defense of its own.

A representation of the majestic head of the male, with its spreading antlers, was adopted as the first badge of the Order; and is still the most conspicuous element of its fraternal emblem.


