## July 2024 Elk of the Month

Elk of the month is Rex Allen Roussell. Rex was born June 4, 1960, in the small town of Elmira, NY. He is the middle child of 13 brothers and sisters. In 1977 at the age of 17 he left Elmira to pursue a military career in the United States Navy. After bootcamp he was stationed on the USS Midway in Japan as E3 Ship Company Air Department. He then moved through the different Duty Stations, USS Carl Vincent, and then a shore station Nas Whidbey Island WA, NAS Oceana Virgina Beach, VA, NASJRB Willow Grove PA, then back to NAS Whidbey Island WA, where he retired from the military service after 22 years. After retiring Rex stayed in Washington State where he took on several odd jobs. The East coast was calling him back, so he moved to Sebring in December 2010, where he bought into a small business called Jimmy's Lube and Tire. He recalled his father telling him "You must be a jack of all trades, so it's best to learn to adjust to where you live and make a good life for yourself". At Jimmy's he worked on everything Bumper-to-Bumper; then sold the business in 2017 and began traveling the country for a year; returning to Sebring in 2019.
