LEADING KNIGHT


- 1. Assist the Exalted Ruler. This is your first responsibility, support his/her programs, be cooperative.



REMEMBER: These meetings are open to all current members. Please show up and welcome our new members each month


Member Orientation and Initiation will be August 11th




