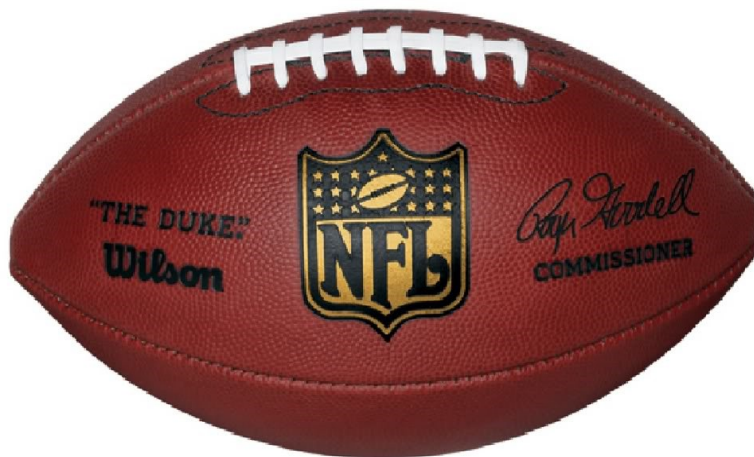


Welcome members to football season

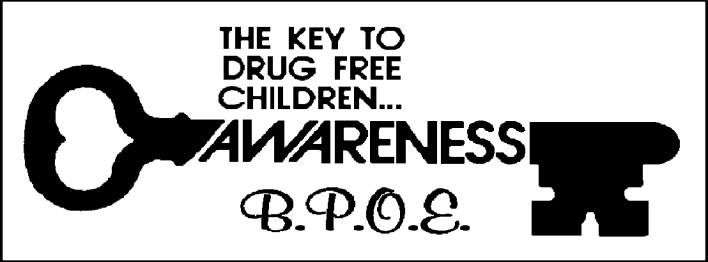

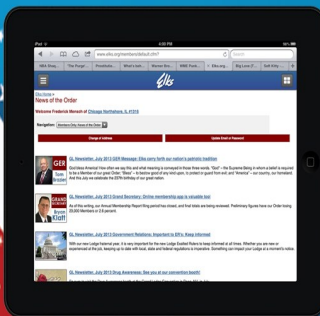

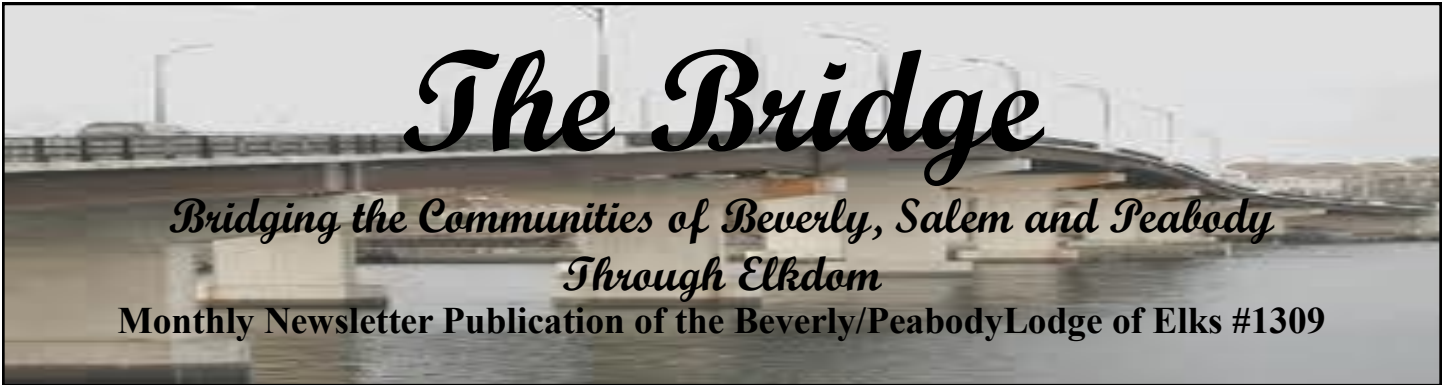
