## FROM OUR EXALTED RULER

On September 4th the House Committee met at its normally scheduled monthly meeting. Earlier this summer, we coordinated with the Board of Directors to establish a lodge rule about a 9 PM curfew for anyone under the age of 21. Recently, we discovered 4603 that a modification needed to be made to this for the betterment of the members of the lodge.

The House Committee wants to make sure that our lodge is protected and make sure our staff are not put in difficult situations. We also want to ensure that our members and their guests can come enjoy the lodge and get home safely. Several times throughout the year we have special events, sporting events, fundraisers, and entertainment hosted at the lodge where families can come enjoy the lodge and contribute to these events. At times, these events 5154 go on after 9 PM. Effectively immediately, if you are a member in good standing with dues paid and you bring your child (under 21) to an event in the upstairs portion of the lodge, we ask that you to check in with the on-duty bartender, a house committee member, or

board of director to get your family member an arm band to signify they are under the age of 21. The bands we have ordered are shown at the bottom of this post. They will be kept at the bar. By doing this it will help our staff and also ensure that families can enjoy these events at our lodge. It can also allow our members and their quests a reliable mode of transportation if needed. It shall be the responsibility of the member to ensure you have checked in your child. Once the member leaves the lodge, the child must also leave at that time along with any other signed in guest. Guests are allowed three visits before they must make a decision if they want to sign up to 3666 become a member. Please remember to sign your guest in at the front entryway. (This does not apply to spouses/significant others of active members) If you have a guest that is under 21 that is not your child, they will need to leave the lodge by the 9 PM curfew during that event. They will also need to check in and receive an arm band upon arriving at the lodge that evening.

Furthermore, nobody under the age of 21 is permitted to sit at the bar. (Per Missouri Alcohol & Tobacco Control)

If you attend an event at the lodge, and need to check in and the on-duty bar staff is busy at that time, feel free to reach out to one of the following committee members or directors. (see listed names below)

The House Committee & Board of Directors want to see this lodge be successful now and, in the future, but we will need the help of our members by following these small requests we have. Disciplinary hearings may be held for individuals who knowingly fail to follow these requests. I have the utmost confidence in our members that this

should not be a problem for our lodge. 4915 I understand not all of our decisions will satisfy everyone, but we try to make the best decision overall for the greater good of the lodge. Anyone wanting to be a part of a committee or the board, I highly recommend reaching out to future ERs on your interest in those 5377 positions.
