From Our Secretary's Desk

Hello fellow Elks and welcome to Fall. As I write this letter today, I have been reviewing our membership numbers from past years and find it fascinating how much we have grown in such a short time. In my term as secretary, we have gone from 1371 members to 1467 in just six months. I looked back on our numbers from previous years and found the following

- April 2014 657 members
- April 2015 693 members
- April 2016 703 members
- April 2017 766 members

As you can see the lodge has had about 40 to 50 new members each year, yet in the last six months we have increased by 96 new members and have 35 more in process. I would like to recognize our top proposers this year:

- Mike Dudzinski 10 new members
- Elbert Gray 5 new members
- Alicia Fiducia 4 new members
- Dylan Bassett 4 new members.

Thank you all for your support in our growth and please keep the push going.

With this type of growth projection, we will have "2202" members by 2027. This will require some planning for infrastructure as well as property and grounds improvements and staff to support our new members. The board of Directors has started this planning process and will plan to share with the membership as they develop.

The biggest need for increased growth is the need for increased support in our Lodge. Are you involved? Have you volunteered to join a committee or help at an event. This is your Lodge, and you get out of it what you put into it. Come out to a meeting and see what is happening and how you can get involved. The attendance in our by-weekly meetings could use a push and we want to hear from you and welcome your input.

New member growth is our lifeline, and the grand lodge has continued the award pin, watch and clock program until June 2025. For every 3 new or reinstated members proposed and initiated by a member during the Grand Exalted rulers' term they become eligible for a membership recruiting pin. Achieving 11 new members makes you eligible for an Elks watch, and reaching 33 new members makes you eligible for an

Elks desk clock. Each award includes a signed thank you letter from the Grand Exalted Ruler. This recognition program runs from July 1st to June 15, 2025.

Thanks again for helping increase our membership and bringing your family and friends to join us. The Glastonbury Lodge has continued to grow, and your support and involvement is what has gotten us here. Thank you for all you do to support this great organization. I'm looking forward to a great fall season and hope to see you all come out and get the most out of our Lodge.

- > Trap is open to the public. Eye and hearing protection are required in order to use the range and shoot trap. <u>Starts at 11am.</u>
- > Reminder: 2202 members can bring a guest to the range twice after which the guest must become a member of 2202 to continue to come to the range. (this does not apply to immediate family members)
- > Range Committee meets the 1st Wednesday of the month at 6:30pm



Anyone unauthorized, found to be at the range will be prosecuted.

New Requirements for Steel Targets!

All steel targets must move!

i.e. swing, deflect down or spin. (AR500 or AR550 Steel Recommended)

ABSOLUTELY NO stationary steel
 targets allowed!

*This means not leaning on the backstop or propped up by wood, stone or any other material.







Minimum Distances Required:

(metal targets):

- 30 FEET for .22 caliber rimfire pistol and rimfire rifle.
- 25 YARDS for centerfire handguns (9mm, .38 caliber etc.) and shot guns shooting lead shot.
- 100 YARDS for centerfire rifle (.556, 308, 30-30, .50 caliber, etc.) and shotguns shooting slugs.










