## COMING STRAIGHT FROM GRAND LODGE AND POSTS ABOUT ALCOHOL

"The situation is more complex than it appears. While certain practices may seem acceptable, it's vital to avoid anything that promotes excessive drinking, such as "all you can drink" or "bottomless glass" offers. A particular concern is the posting of photos from events where alcohol is being consumed. Attorneys have used these images against Lodges in cases where members or guests were involved in alcohol-related accidents or arrested for DWI. Under the Dram Shop Act, this has led to Lodges losing money in lawsuits. Furthermore, members have filed lawsuits against Lodges for posting photos of them drinking, which can be discovered by employers or potential employers, spouses/ former spouses (fighting over things like child visitation rights) during social media checks, potentially harming their reputation as responsible individuals. Our Lodges have faced financial penalties in these types of cases.

The real issue extends beyond the Elks' image—it's about legal exposure and the substantial financial losses that come with it. Unfortunately, Lodge leadership often overlooks these risks until they're faced with a costly lawsuit. To mitigate these risks, event flyers must be crafted with care, emphasizing the responsible serving of alcohol, which must be strictly enforced. Additionally, no photos of members drinking should be allowed. The legal exposure and financial losses have already driven up the cost of the Liquor Liability Insurance that Lodges must pay. Taking these precautions is essential to protect the Lodge from further risk."
