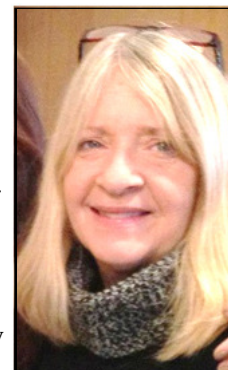


### Elk of the Month
