Membership Retention and Lapsation

We are just past the halfway mark in the Elks year. We still have so much work to do in regards to membership and lapsation. We have made some progress in reducing lapsation numbers but as of this writing there are still 41 members who have not paid their dues for this year. That equates to $114.50 \times 41 = 4,694.50$ in unpaid dues that we are unable to utilize to help run the daily operations.

Sponsors, I urge you to reach out to any member you brought in to make sure their dues are paid. You are an integral part in this process. Lapsation is currently at 7.5%; goal is 2%.

Our Lodges' current membership number is 558. We are growing but I would like to encourage members to sign up new members. That is one of the ways you can be a part of helping our Lodge and Elkdom in general. Membership is the life blood of our Order.
