Our Lodge exists because of the hardworking members and their charitable contributions and time and effort. They support our state's major projects and that in turn allows us to have a Lodge and social quarters to have a friendly place to gather.

Veteran Eric Lema and his two twin daughters, Raelynn and Raediance receive items from the Gainesville Elks Lodge 990 Welcome Home Project. The girls are seen with their two new beds and bedding. Eric and his family received other donated furniture and various items that were purchased through the Welcome Home Kits program for their household. Gainesville Elks Lodge 990 continues to utilize the Elks National Veterans Service Commission welcome home kits to help local veterans move from homelessness into independent living. The lodge partners with the local HUD-VASH Honor Center to receive the names of veterans and their families in need. To date, the Lodge has submitted 30 welcome home kits for reimbursement through ENF for a total of over 100 veterans and their families serviced.

Welcome home kits are intended to help lodges serve veterans who are exiting homelessness and entering permanent housing. The kits provide reimbursement (per veteran) of up to \$400 per kit and up to \$600 for each kit that includes a bed. Gainesville Elks 990 has been utilizing the welcome home kit program since 2022.

We will have multiple items up for bid in the silent auction as well as items up for drawings in our raffle.



While today you will find Elks Lodge No. 990 at this address, hidden behind the building is the former Glen Springs Pool, which closed in 1970. Tom Petty's mom, Kitty, would bring him here during his childhood. It is part of the "Dreamville" song lyric from the 2002 album "The Last DJ" -- although one could wonder whether the year-round 72-degree water was so cold it turns lips blue:

"Ridin' with my mama

To Glen Springs Pool

The water was cold

My lips were blue

There was rock and roll

Across the dial

When I think of her

It makes me smile

Like it was Dreamville

A long time ago

A million miles away

All the trees were green

In Dreamville"

Today the staff of the Elks Lodge does its best with limited resources to maintain the historic pool, which was built in stages, starting in the late 1920s. Members of the Elks Lodge clean the pool periodically throughout the year, as a sense of pride, they said. After a heavy rain washed sand from nearby development into the spring pool, they tediously removed all of the sand from this pool. In different sections of the pool today you can find turtles, fish and crawfish.


