We held an open house on October 8th to discuss the plans for the Lodge expansion project and to review the drawings. Lots of support for the project and some good ideas were brought up. I have a meeting next month at the Nevada State Elks conference for the next step in the review and approval process.

We met with the City of Mesquite Planning and Zoning to review our plan and received nothing but positive feedback.

Within the last couple of weeks we have received over \$26,000 in donations earmarked for building expansion! \$10,000 has been promised in matching funds. When matched, this will bring our total to well over \$36,000. With every donation made, the less we will have to borrow to finance the completion of construction. A huge Thank You to all that have stepped forward to support this very important project. Every dollar counts as we get closer to achieving our goal.




