Applications for the 2025 Most Valuable Student scholarship are now closed. We will begin judging the applications Dec 6 and will have to be completed by Dec 23,2024. All judging is done online. If you are interested in scoring the applications this year, please let Pam Taylor or Cheryl Warner know.

**ENF Legacy Scholarship**

The 2025 contest and application is open. Legacy Awards are \$4,000 scholarships available to children and grandchildren of Elks members. The applicant must apply online only. The 2025 Legacy Awards application deadline is February 3, 2025, 11:59 a.m. Pacific Time. NOTE: This is NOON, mid-day, Pacific time.

1. If the applicant's parent and grandparent are both Elk members, the applicant must apply through the parent's Elks Lodge.
2. We have waived the standardized test requirement for the 2025 Legacy contest. You do not need to submit ACT and/or SAT scores.
3. Legacy Awards may only be applied to accredited US American schools, colleges or universities.
4. 2025 Legacy Awards recipients will be required to perform three instances of service with an Elks Lodge during the four years they are receiving the scholarship.
