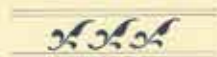

## THE ELKS..

**T**HOUGH only organized some thirty years ago, the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of the United States of America is already one of the strongest and most powerful secret societies in the land.

The primary organization was composed of some half score of theatrical men who formed a small club in New York City in the winter of '67 and '68, the sole object of the club being to promote sociability and good fellowship. They were bright, energetic, wide-awake men of the world. Their occasional meetings were enlivened by good cheer; merry stories were told and jolly songs were sung, each member contributing in turn to the general enjoyment under heavy pains and penalties in case of a failure to properly gratify the circle of his expectant and merciless critics. Woe to the unfortunate wight who failed to remember the point to his story or undertook to inflict upon his auditors what in this day and generation is known as a "chestnut."

This traditional custom of exacting fines for all sins of "commission and omission" has been faithfully handed down and observed to the present day, a circumstance which nearly every Elk has cause to remember.

In the early days of the Order the leading spirit at their social sessions was one Charles Vivian, a young English actor and singer; he it was who christened the club "The Jolly Corks," and was by his enthusiastic companions dubbed "The Imperial Cork." From

what little we can gather of our early history, Charles Vivian seems to have been an inimitable singer of old English songs and rollicking Irish airs; "a fellow of infinite jest and most excellent fancy," who led the spirit of conviviality among the "Jolly Corks" and was master of their revels. As it is owing to his suggestion that the club be organized and made perpetual, a word in passing as to his fate and the regard with which his memory is cherished by our Order may not be inappropriate.

"After life's fitful fever he sleeps well" at the base of a noble monument erected to the memory of their founder by his Brother Elks. It has been given to but few men to perform so lasting a life work as his, for to-day nearly 100,000 Elks revere his memory; "they have written his faults upon the sands, his virtues on enduring tablets," and at lodge meetings or banquet table when the mystic moment comes, his is the name, preeminent among all others, when cups are raised in response to our "Absent Brothers."

The "Jolly Corks" grew so rapidly in repute that admission to its doors became sought after by members of all professions and by business men generally, although the idea at first was to make it exclusively a theatrical organization. At this time no regular system of management for its affairs had been perfected, nor had the club even a home that its members could call their own.

Early in the winter of 1868, at Vivian's instance steps were taken to place the society on a more enduring basis than that of the first crude beginning, and after much discussion it was finally determined to make it a National Order and to change the cognomen of the club so as to give it a distinctively American name.

The committee to select a new name were Charles Vivian, Richard Stierly, Thos. G. Riggs, Harry Vandermark and Geo. F. McDonald. On February 16th, 1868, the name of Elk was adopted, and the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of to-day was launched to "sink or swim, survive or perish" on the sea of popular approval. How well the good ship has steered clear of every rock and weathered every tempest is attested by the fact that to-day 600 lodges respond to our roll call throughout the Union, and that the old lodges are increasing in membership and new lodges springing into existence with astounding rapidity.

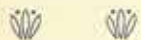

## OUR LODGE



**N**EW PHILADELPHIA Lodge No. 510, of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks was instituted under a dispensation granted by Grand Exalted Ruler Galvin on the 8th day of June, 1899. The petition for the establishment of this lodge was signed by the following members: Dr. R. S. Barton, Canton Lodge No. 68; H. B. Lukens, Wheeling Lodge No. 28; Thos. Furey, Wheeling Lodge No. 28; A. E. Getz, J. F. Gerber, Jno. Reusser, and C. A. Conway, of Uhrichsville Lodge No. 424.

It was the aim of the committee who had in charge the matter of securing a charter list—J. F. Gerber, A. E. Getz, and C. A. Conway—to get as many of the representative citizens of this city and Canal Dover as possible, and they succeeded far better than they could possibly have anticipated. The charter list contained the names of forty-three members, thirty-six of whom took the degree on the day of installation.

The lodge was duly organized by Bro. E. M. Campfield, of Findlay, O., District Deputy for the Northern District of Ohio, assisted by a team made up of brothers from Massillon, Cleveland, Conton, Mansfield, Salem, Findlay and Uhrichsville.

In a little over a year's time we have more than doubled our membership, and are rejoiced to say that so far we have lost but one member from our roster, Bro. Thos. Furey, who withdrew by dimit from our lodge on again becoming a resident of Wheeling, W. Va., of whose lodge he was originally a member.

We have ever since our organization occupied quarters in the Independent Order of Odd Fellow's Temple on South Broadway, and while our rooms are well arranged and commodious, yet like all young and ambitious orders we hope that the day may soon come when we may be sheltered under a roof of our own.

Under the able, wise and conservative leadership of our present officials we hope very soon to obtain our desire, and we purpose never to rest from our labors until the day comes when we may be able to offer to all weary and travel-stained Elks, who may sojourn in our manor, the well-known hospitality of an up-to-date Elks' club.

In the month of February, 1871, the original lodge of Elks in New York City of their own accord created a Grand Lodge and surrendered

to it the final control of all Elk lodges. The lodge in New York City became New York Lodge No. 1, and two days later Philadelphia Lodge No. 2 was organized. Now there are 600 lodges in the United States. It is not difficult to ascertain wherein lies the secret of our amazing strength as a secret organization. We permit no additions to our order except from among the ranks of broad-minded, liberal and progressive men whose every act and expression must be in unison with the principle of universal toleration of all other beliefs—religious and secular. The Order seeks to impress upon its members that each individual must exemplify in his every-day life "the principles of love of family and home, of justice, honesty, manhood, the protection of women and children, and practical charity." The order encourages every form of harmless enjoyment and social recreation, and its members individually believe in every word of the old lines—

"Laugh, and the world laughs with you,  
Weep, and you weep alone;  
For this sad old earth has to borrow its mirth,  
It has troubles enough of its own."

We may say in passing that it is a very cold day when a lodge of Elks can't find something to laugh at. We believe in liberality and charity. Let misfortune and calamity assail an Elk and every member of the Order stands ready to assist him. In health and in sickness, in good fortune and in bad fortune, in good repute and in evil repute, we stand by our brothers so long as they are worthy. At the same time we tolerate no mendicancy; we permit no sponging upon the good nature or charity of the Order. Let one forget his obligations to his family and to society, to law and order, to his home and his country, and he has violated his word of honor and is no longer an Elk. Every member of the Order must continue to live up to the stand-

ard required for his admission. If he finds the struggle of life too hard, loses ambition and energy, becomes content to drift with wave and tide, and seeks to live on the remembrance of his earlier virtues and brighter past; if he besots himself in the gulf of intemperance or stains his hands with crime, the Order knows him no longer. To merit recognition from the Elks when in tribulation or adversity, an Elk must struggle for himself, fight the battle of life with every force of his brain and every muscle of his body that it is left to him to exert; his ambition and energy must never flag, and so long as he retains, by his efforts and struggles, the respect of his fellow citizens, he will be aided under all circumstance by the Elks in no unstinted measure and with no niggard hand.

Hon. Martin A. Foran, in the following eloquent language, has told all the story of the Elks' belief and creed.

"The Order of Elks differs materially from all other social and fraternal organizations. Its charity is broader, its humanity deeper, its purpose nobler, its aim higher. Believing that all men are by nature brothers, its great aim is to make them such in fact. The true Elk is an altruist, an idealist, and a lover of his brother; a man who believes, and acts upon the belief, that the secret of human happiness is to make others happy. To do good unselfishly, to everywhere diffuse the sunlight of joy, to lift up the lowly and oppressed, to dry the orphan's tears, assuage the widow's grief, to pluck from every heart the sting of sorrow, to broaden human vision, to intellectualize humanity, to destroy selfishness, prejudice and hate; to prevent corrosion of the soul by the dry rot of gain; to, in a word, make the story of Genesis—that man was created in the image of God—something more than a mocking echo; to crystallize the story into a living fact, an immortal truth—all these are the sum of the Elks' creed." (Memorial Day address, delivered at East Liverpool, O., Dec. 1, 1895.)

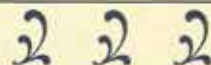

Of pure, fresh, country air.

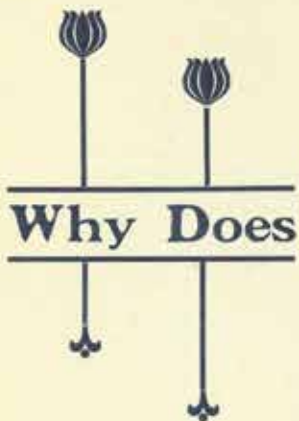
