


Greetings, Elkdom!



#### Drug Awareness Committee Chairperson Rosemarie Smith

Our Lodge Drug Awareness Program's Mission is to inspire, to educate, to support, and to assist our schools and community.



Elks National Drug Awareness Program - the largest volunteer drug awareness program in the United States. We are very proud of our dedicated army of volunteers who freely give their time and talents to this most noble cause.

The Elks are committed to eliminating the use and abuse of illegal drugs by all members of society and believe that in order to ensure a bright future for our country, it is essential that our children be raised in a drug-free environment.

This month I would like to talk about **FentanyI**, which is the leading cause of drug related deaths for Americans 18 to 49. In Riverside County alone, there is at least one fentanyl-related deaths every day. Teen overdose rates are the **highest** in history. The DEA estimates that 6 out of 10 fentanyl laced pills contain a lethal amount for overdose (one pill can kill).

**Fentanyl** is a potent synthetic opioid drug approved by the Food and Drug Administration for use as an analgesic (pain relief) and anesthetic. It is approximately 100 times more potent than morphine and 50 times more potent than heroin as an analgesic.

**Fentanyl** can be snorted/sniffed, smoked, orally by pill or tablet, spiked onto blotter paper, patches, sold alone or in combination with heroin and other substances, has been identified in fake pills, mimicking pharmaceutical drugs such as oxycodone. Similar to other opioid analgesics, fentanyl produces effects such as: relaxation, euphoria, pain relief, sedation, confusion, drowsiness, dizziness, nausea and vomiting, urinary retention, pupillary constriction, and respiratory depression.

#### What can we do as Elks?

Educating ourselves and educating our youth is where we begin. Contacting our local agencies and rehabilitation facilities to get information and see what programs they offer. I am attaching Links for your reference.

Notes: Developing a strong bond with your children at an early age is important, but as the parent or grandparent, it is your job to provide the rules, structure, and discipline to raise a healthy child. Be a parent, not a pal. Set rules and consequences for breaking Structure, communication help to discourage drug use those rules. Your children will surely test you by pushing the boundaries. This is to be expected. Stay strong and follow through with the consequences that you set. Children and grandchildren of Elks need to know that without boundaries, they will be lost.




